

Day Camp Information



Check-in is on Monday morning in the Day Camp building. All campers need to have an adult accompany them to check-in the first week they attend each summer. After that first week, campers may check in unaccompanied if their camp fees for the week are paid in full. If you don't have time for check-in on Monday morning, you may register on Sunday evening from 6:00-6:30 pm in the main office.

Please bring: any remaining balance for the week, your completed health form (one per summer), towel, modest swimsuit (see dress guidelines below), complete change of clothes and Bible. Please label all items all items with your camper's name (including sunscreen, see below).

Optional things to bring: money for the camp store (cash only, please) and sunscreen. If you would like a camp staff member to help apply sunscreen to your camper, your camper needs to bring spray-on sunscreen.

Please don't bring: cell phone, portable music player, video games, pets, alcohol, illegal drugs, weapons or fireworks.

Lunch and a snack are provided.

Daily sign in: Your child needs to sign in everyday; you may accompany them or drop them off at the curb. Normal arrival is from 8:30-9:00 am.

Daily sign out: Each day, please come to the Day Camp area to sign out your child. You may authorize additional people to pick up your camper at registration or by contacting the main office. Normal pick-up is from 4:30-5:00 pm.

Early arrival/late pick-up: For \$30 each week, you may add an early arrival and/or a late pick-up. Early arrival is from 7:30-8:30 am each morning. If your camper arrives by 7:45 am, we will provide breakfast. Late pick-up is from 5:00-6:00 pm each evening. If your camper is still here at 5:00 pm, we will provide dinner. We can pro-rate one week of early arrival/late pick-up per camper; any other partial weeks will be the full fee.

Access: Please use the main camp entrance and main parking lot.

Camp Store: Campers must deposit any spending money (cash only, please) into a camp store account. Any money not spent during the week will be returned at sign-out on Friday. Campers attending more than one session of Day Camp may leave their money in their account. Any money remaining at camp at the end of September will be donated to the camp.

Campers are expected to: attend all meals, meetings, and activities unless excused by the camp nurse or day camp director, wear shoes at all times, dress & behave modestly, respect those in authority, adhere to water safety rules, not display romantic affection (holding hands, kissing, etc), and not use offensive language.

Dress guidelines: Girls: No two-piece swimsuits of any kind. (Campers may wear a tankini covered with a dark-colored t-shirt.) No bare midriffs, no spaghetti-strap tank tops or dresses. No strapless anything. Be mindful of shorts that are too short.
Boys: No Speedo-type swimsuits. No underwear above the waistline.

Teammate requests: We can honor teammate requests for at least your first two day camps. Teammates need to be within one grade of each other and the older will join the younger.

Phone calls to or from the camper are allowed only in an emergency.

Avoid visiting a child during camp to ensure a consistent camp experience for all campers. If you do visit, you must register with the camp office upon arrival.

Partial weeks: Each summer, we will pro-rate one week of Day Camp per camper. Any additional partial weeks will be the full camp fee. This policy also applies to early arrival/late pick-up.

Transfer Fee: You may transfer money from one camp to another camp for a \$5.00 bookkeeping fee for each transaction. There is no fee to transfer money from one camper to another camper in the same camp session.

Cancellation policy: Deposits (the first \$50 for overnight camps, \$30 for day camp) are non-refundable, unless you cancel at least one month before the camp begins. Any payments over and above the deposit will be returned if you cancel at least 48 hours before the camp begins. We will return the full payment (including deposit) when cancellation is for medical reasons or a family emergency. No refund will be given for: a dismissal due to disciplinary action, homesickness, late arrival, early departure (except for sickness or family emergency) or for campers who do not attend and do not notify the camp of the cancellation. To cancel or change your registration, contact the main office by phone, email or in person.
